Project Overview:

The NNSA Consortium Internship Program, together with Society for Advancement of Chicanos and Native Americans in Science (SACNAS), Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers (SHPE) and Society of Mexican American Engineers and Scientists (MAES), is providing undergraduate and master's students with challenging, hands-on, educational internship opportunities in a federal laboratory or office. In coming years, the program will be open to post-doctoral students. Internship locations include: Washington, D.C.; Texas; New Mexico; California; Nevada; and Tennessee.

- Chosen candidates receive a paid 10 week summer program, up to \$6,000 for undergraduates and \$7,200 for graduate students or a paid 15 week semester internship, up to \$9,000 for undergraduate students and up to \$10,800 for graduate students at the National Nuclear Security Administration
- Round trip travel to and from site

Further, students who complete additional requirements are also eligible:

- To receive funding for GRE fees and/or the cost of graduate school applications
- To have transportation costs covered as well as waived registration fees for attendance at the Consortium Conferences
- Become a NNSA Consortium Internship Program Ambassador

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a member of SACNAS, SHPE or MAES
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be a full-time college rising junior, rising senior or graduate student enrolled in an accredited college/university in the United States or Puerto Rico
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA as an undergraduate student; Minimum 3.25 GPA as a graduate student
- Be in pursuit of degree in science, engineering, technology or math

Internships are offered year-round:

Summer:	10 Weeks	June – Aug
Fall:	15 Weeks	Sept – Dec
Spring:	15 Weeks	Jan – April
